Equipment that can NOT be found is automatically NOT permitted.

Category C: Level Pre-B, B and E

No mounted exhibitor may wear or carry an electronic verbal communication device (i.e., cellular telephone, pager, walkie talkie, etc.) while in the competition ring.

The penalty for wearing or carrying a forbidden device may be elimination from the class during which the device was worn or carried.

Auxiliary Reins

415	Auxiliary reins are permitted in Category C.
416	Auxiliary reins are not permitted to be too tight: The horse's nose needs to remain at or in front of the vertical.
417	Side reins (with or without rubber)
418	Vienna (running) side reins
419	Single side rein (bumper rein)with bit connector, with or w/o rubber.
420	Running martingale (Brestplate or simple version)
421	Standing martingale (Breastpalte or simple version)
422	Elastic neck stretcher

Reins

423	Permitted reins: Web reins, leather reins, rubber reins, soft grip reins, braided reins, hybrid reins
424	Not permitted: Reins that have any kind of (hand) loop, laced reins, elastic reins, elastic section reins

442	Horse boots and polo wraps are permitted in the warmup arena.
443	In the show ring, the horse is not permitted to wear boots, polo wraps etc.

Head Number

444	Competition numbers have to be attached on both sides of the horse (head, breast plate or saddle pad).

Martingales

515	Martingales have to be used in a conventional manner.
516	Draw reins and German martingales are only permitted in warm-up rides at Category A.
517	The "FreeJump collar" (for hand stability) is permitted.
518	Cable or metal tie downs are prohibited for use on horses and ponies.
519	Auxiliary reins mentioned in 416/417/418/419 are permitted in the warm up on the flat, but prohibited for jumping.
520	Running martingale (Brestplate or simple version) is permitted.
521	Standing martingale (Breastpalte or simple version) is only permitted in Category C.
